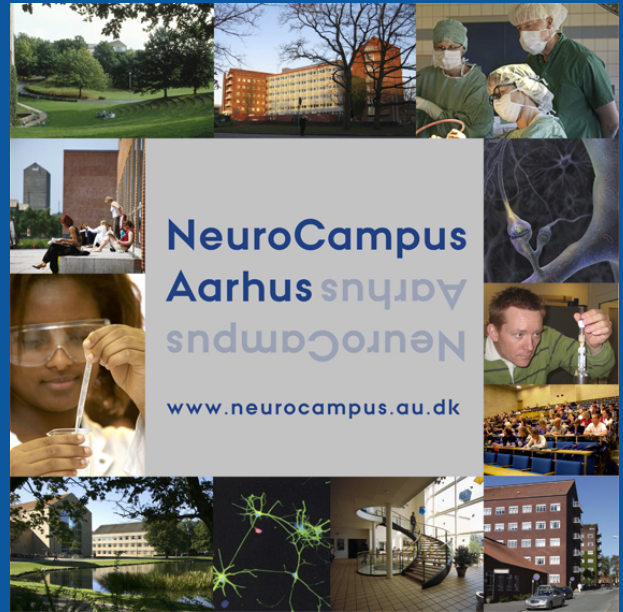


Reviving NeuroCampus

In 2009 a number of faculty members from health and natural sciences took the initiative to establish NeuroCampus (NCA) as an umbrella organization with the intent of strengthening interdisciplinary and translational neuroscience at Aarhus University. One of the key objectives of NCA was to provide subsidies for new collaborative interdisciplinary projects. Unfortunately, NCA was not selected at that time to be one of the interdisciplinary centres funded by the university. As a consequence, planned activities, including a seminar series were never initiated and NCA slowly became dormant.

However, the NCA is waking up again. The steering committee has been fortified by a number of younger colleagues and we are preparing to revive NCA in the hope that there are a number of scientists, senior and junior who are willing to back a new initiative.
