- Extract notes from articles you read for fast and efficient access later
- Integrate references and notes using the software **Zotero** for reference management and **Obsidian** for note-taking
- Connect your notes to their source using citekeys providing **instantaneous** access with mouse cursor to preview your **colour-specific annotations, images, article PDFs, and article-specific notes**
- Bring laptop and download Zotero and Obsidian in advance
- You will be guided through downloading plugins and scripts – **we'll take it slow and from scratch!**
