The arguments why we have chosen Euroasia as a main focus of the conference in 2014:

- 1. Russia produces more academic graduates per academic year than any other European country.
- 2. According to the Chinese Ministry of Education, a total of 399,600 Chinese students went to study abroad last year.
- 3. There were 106,104 young Vietnamese studying in 49 countries and territories in 2012, according to the Vietnam MHE.
- 4. The number of Indian students going overseas to study rose a stunning 256% from 53,266 to 189,629 in just nine years.
- 5. With a population of about 180 million, Pakistan is the world's sixth most populous country. Two-thirds of the population are under the age of 30, and half are under 20 years old. By 2060, Pakistan's population is projected to be 285 million.
- 6. Malaysia is going to become the world's sixth-biggest education exporting country by 2020 with a target of 200,000 students.
- 7. Scholarship programs are developing in many Eurasian countries. For example, Russia recently announced a new program for study abroad worth USD 165 million. According to New Libyan scholarship program it is planned to send 41,000 students abroad.
- **8.** 2014 Winter Olympics and FIFA 2018 in Russia have special cooperation demands. Undoubtedly the IUNC 2014 is the best opportunity to set up cooperation with Russian universities to satisfy staff preparation demand for these world-famous events.


