PHD COURSE: HOW TO GET PUBLISHED

- Understand how the peer-review system works
- Develop a better understanding of how to write your own abstract

Aim of the Course

The aim of this course is to make the participants aware of how to develop effective writing strategies to target different readerships within academic publishing. Furthermore, the participants will be introduced to how to think strategically about publication. This aim will be targeted through a focus on abstract writing during the afternoon workshop.
